

DOCTRINE OF APOLOGETICS

6. In Ephesus he spoke in the synagogue and in the school of Tyrannus: “reasoning [dial egomai, to discuss, converse, preach] and persuading [peithw, to persuade, to have confidence] them about the kingdom of God [Acts 19:8]reasoning [dial egomai, to discuss, converse, preach] daily in the school of Tyrannus [Acts 19:9].”
7. Apollos was using apologetics when he discussed the faith with some Jews in Corinth: “for he powerfully refuted [diakatel egcomai, refute completely] the Jews in public, demonstrating [epideiknumi, demonstrate, show, point out] by the Scriptures that Jesus was the Christ” (Acts 18:28).
8. Paul wrote from a Roman prison that he had a ministry of “defense [apologia] and confirmation of the gospel” (Philippians 1:7) and “I am appointed for the defense [apologia] of the gospel” (Philippians 1:16).
9. Paul also instructed Titus that the elders-overseers-pastor-teachers should “be able...to refute [ej egcw, expose, convince, correct] those who contradict” sound doctrine (Titus 1:9).
10. Luke (Luke 1:1-4 and Acts 1:1-3) and Paul (1 Corinthians 15) used evidence to give others a reason to consider that Jesus Christ is the only Savior.
