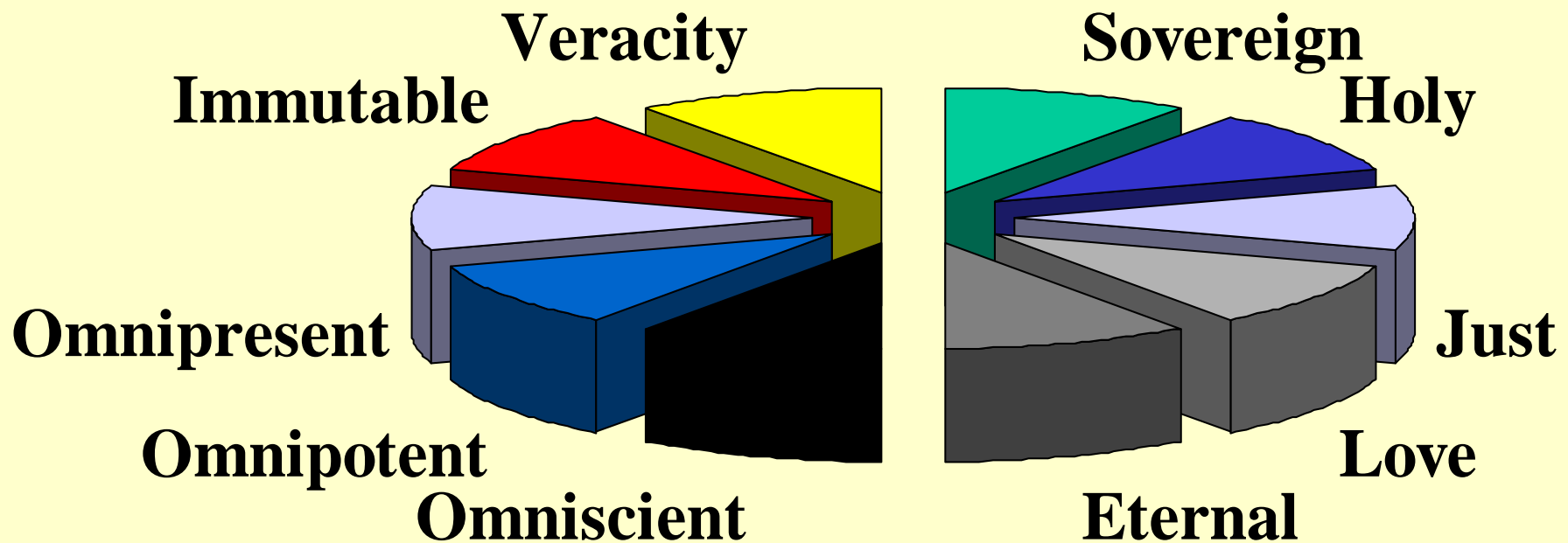


Divine Attributes



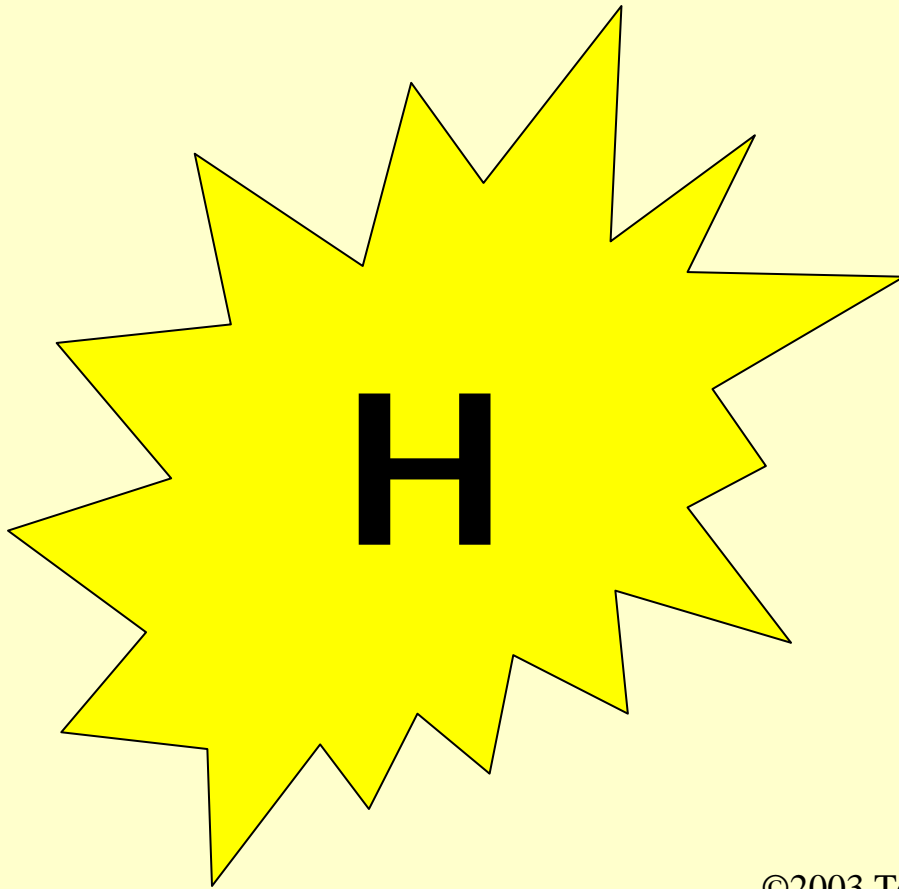
Divine Attributes



Sovereign: He has the will and right to make decisions.

Psalms 135.6 "Whatever the Lord pleases, He does, In heaven and in earth, in the seas and in all deeps."

Divine Attributes



Holy: He is perfect righteousness.

Psalm 99.9 "Exalt the Lord our God, and worship at His holy hill; for holy is the Lord our God."

Divine Attributes



Just: Justice expresses God's Holiness toward His creation.

Psalm 9.8 "And He will judge the world in righteousness; He will execute judgment for the peoples with equity."

Divine Attributes

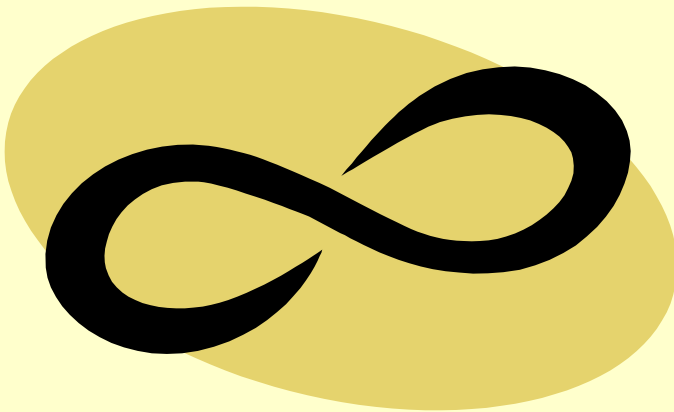


Love: He desires His will and therefore His best for mankind.

1 John 4.8 "The one who does not love does not know God, for God is Love."

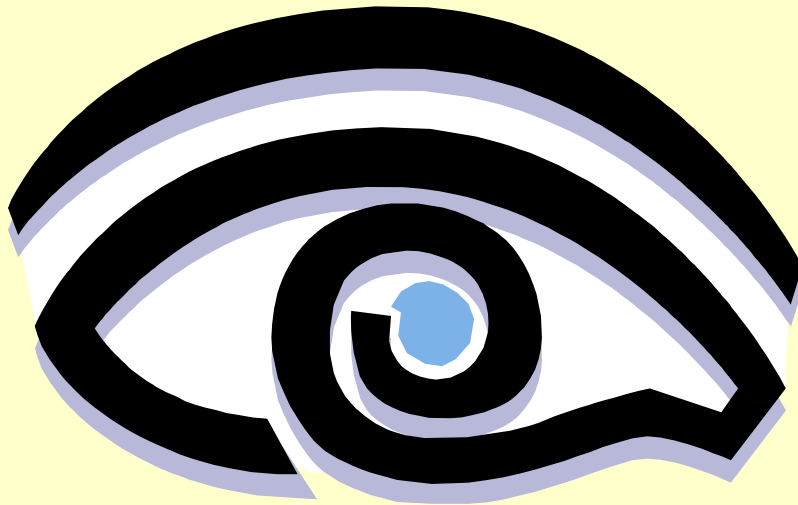
Divine Attributes

Eternal: God has always existed and will always exist.



Psalm 90.2 "Before the mountains were born, or Thou didst give birth to the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, Thou art God."

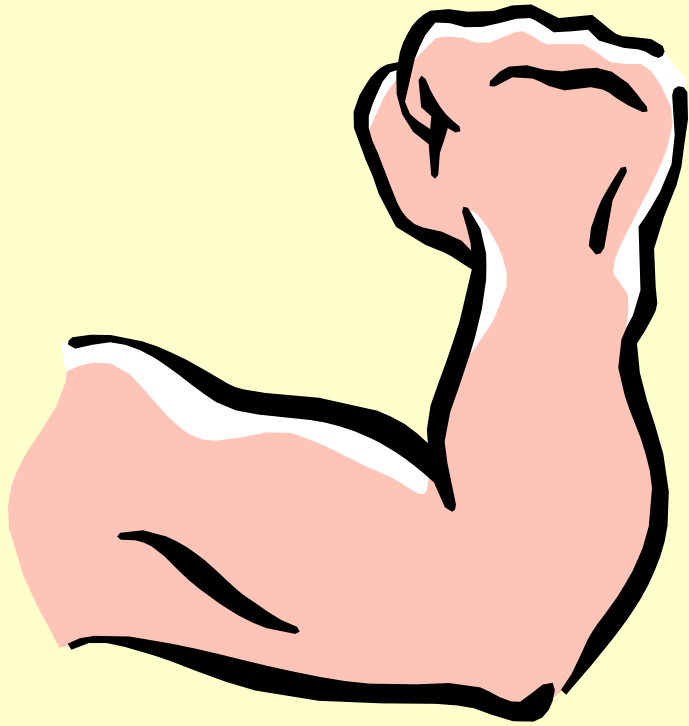
Divine Attributes



Omniscient: God knows everything past, present, and future.

1 John 3.20 "in whatever our heart condemns us; for God is greater than our heart, and knows all things."

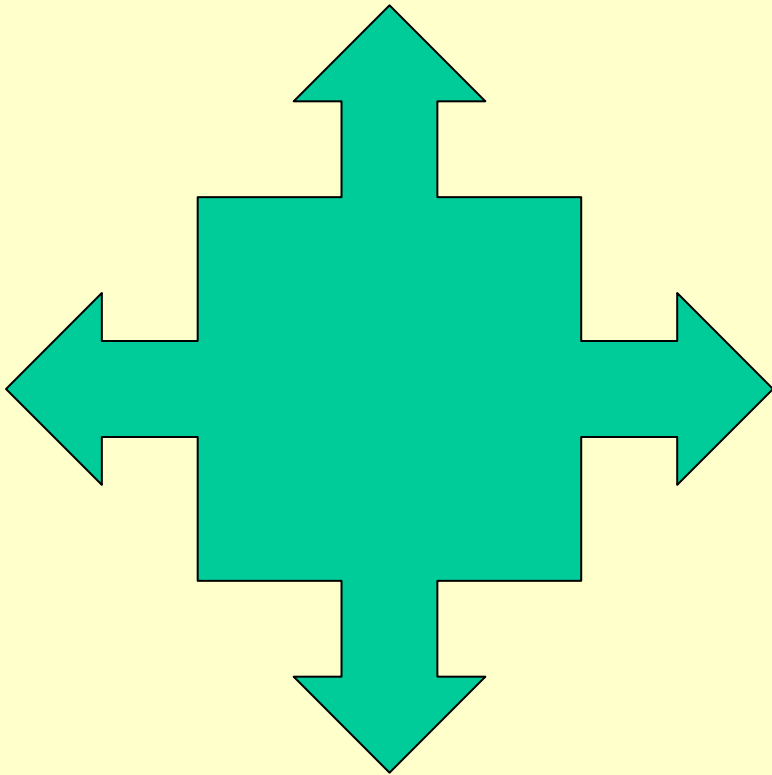
Divine Attributes



Omnipotent: God is able to do anything.

Psalm 147.5 "Great is our Lord, and abundant in strength; His understanding is infinite."

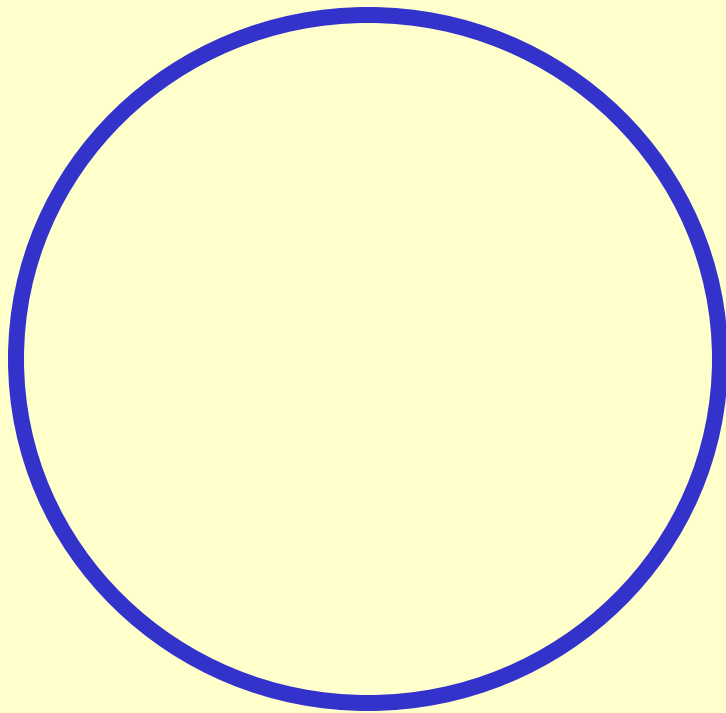
Divine Attributes



Omnipresent: There is no place where God is not present.

Psalm 139.7 "Where can I go from Thy Spirit? Or where can I flee from Thy presence."

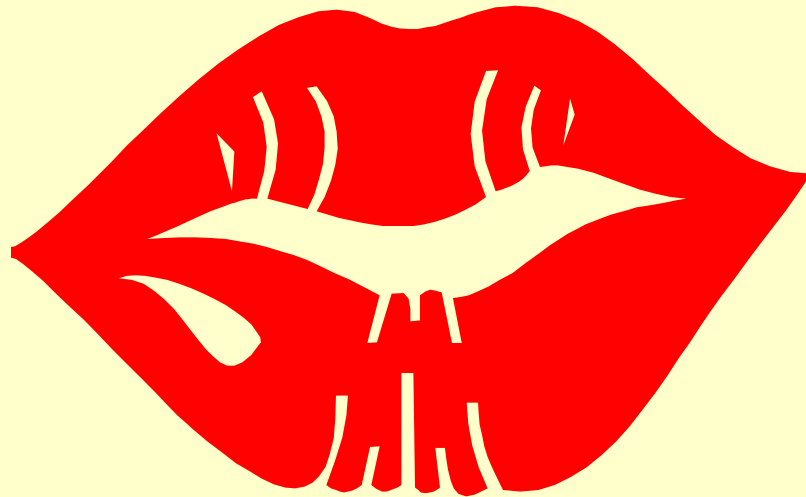
Divine Attributes



Immutable: God is always the same. He does not change.

Malachi 3.6 "For I, the Lord, do not change; therefore you, O sons of Jacob, are not consumed."

Divine Attributes



Veracity: What God says is certain, correct, and dependable.

Titus 1.2 "in the hope of eternal life, which God, who cannot lie, promised long ages ago,"
