Chapter 12: Question 1

1. Summarize the events of John 12.1-8.

- Lazarus: At table eating with Jesus.
- Martha: Serving
- Mary: Anointing Jesus' feet with expensive oil.
- Judas: Complaining about using this oil in this way.

Chapter 12: Question 2

2. What does the answer of Jesus in John 12.7-8 teach us about life?

- Rapport relationship with Jesus is more important than external.
- Expressing worship more important than doing "good."
- Motives are not always pure.

Chapter 12: Question 3

3. What is the significance of John 12.13-16, the Old Testament quotes in particular?

- Thanksgiving psalm for a person that comes from God, in God's power, authority and blessing (Psalm 8.26).
- Prophecy of the coming King of Israel. Judgment of other nations. Protection for Israel.
- Jesus Christ is the prophesied King, Messiah of Israel coming to the nation.

Chapter 12: Question 4

4. Explain John 12.27 "But for this purpose I came for this hour."
(See John 12.23-24, 31-33)

The reason for Jesus Christ pointing to the coming events was to explain the reason for His impending death. His death would judge Satan and offer salvation to the world.

5. Explain John 12.34. (Note Isaiah 9.7; Psalm 110.4; Daniel 7.14; Isaiah 53)

- The Messiah King will reign forever.
- He will dominate all peoples.
- But first, He must suffer according to Isaiah 53.
- The Jews missed this.
