---

1. Why was Nicodemus, a Jewish ruler and religious teacher, attracted to Jesus Christ (John 3.2)?

Signs and Miracles  
semeion (semeion) = distinguishing  
work, miracles

## Chapter 3: Question 2

---

2. What does it mean to be born again (John 3.6, 8; John 1.12-13)?

- To be birthed (made alive) in relation to God by God.
- To be made alive in relationship with God by God.
- To be given life by the Holy Spirit (invisible, unseen).

### Chapter 3: Question 3

---

3. Why does a person need a savior and need to be borne again (John 3.6, 18-21, 36; John 2.24-25)?

- Man is sinful and dead to God.
- Man is born physically alive, but dead in relationship to God.

## Chapter 3: Question 4

---

4. What must a person do in order to be given eternal life (John 3.3, 16-18, 36; John 1.12-13)?

- Receive Jesus Christ (believe in Him).
- Be born from God.
- Believe in Jesus Christ.

## Chapter 3: Question 5

---

5. When John is questioned about Jesus' activities, how does he respond (John 3.26-36)?

- He is glad that Jesus has come, is recognized, and received.
- He wants Jesus Christ to gain popularity and respect.
- He admits he has a lower position, stature, purpose.
- He is a messenger, Jesus is the Son.
