# John Walk Through Summary

## Question 2: Principles Taught

---

- We need our feet washed when dirty. Refers to confession of sin (John 13, 1 John 1).
- Our ministry is that of a gracious servant (John 13)
- Jesus Christ will take us to heaven (John 14).
- We have the privilege and responsibility of prayer in Christ's name (John 14).
- Prayer should be exercised when in fellowship, Bible dominates us (John 15).



# John Walk Through Summary

## Question 2: Principles Taught

---

- The Holy Spirit lives in believers to help, teach, guide, to be the ability and thought (John 14, 16).
- We are totally dependent upon Jesus Christ for the CWL (John 15).
- We are in God's kingdom, in union with Christ, but live in the enemy's territory (John 17).
- Bible doctrine is vital to our priestly ministry on earth (John 17).



## John Walk Through Summary Question 3

---

3. Why did Jesus Christ come to earth, take on a human body, and allow Himself to be arrested (John 1.29, 12.27, 47; 16.8-11)? See also Romans 3.23, 6.23; 1 Corinthians 15.3-4, and John 3.16-18.

It was the Father's plan for Christ to come to earth as the God-man to be judged as the substitute for our sins.

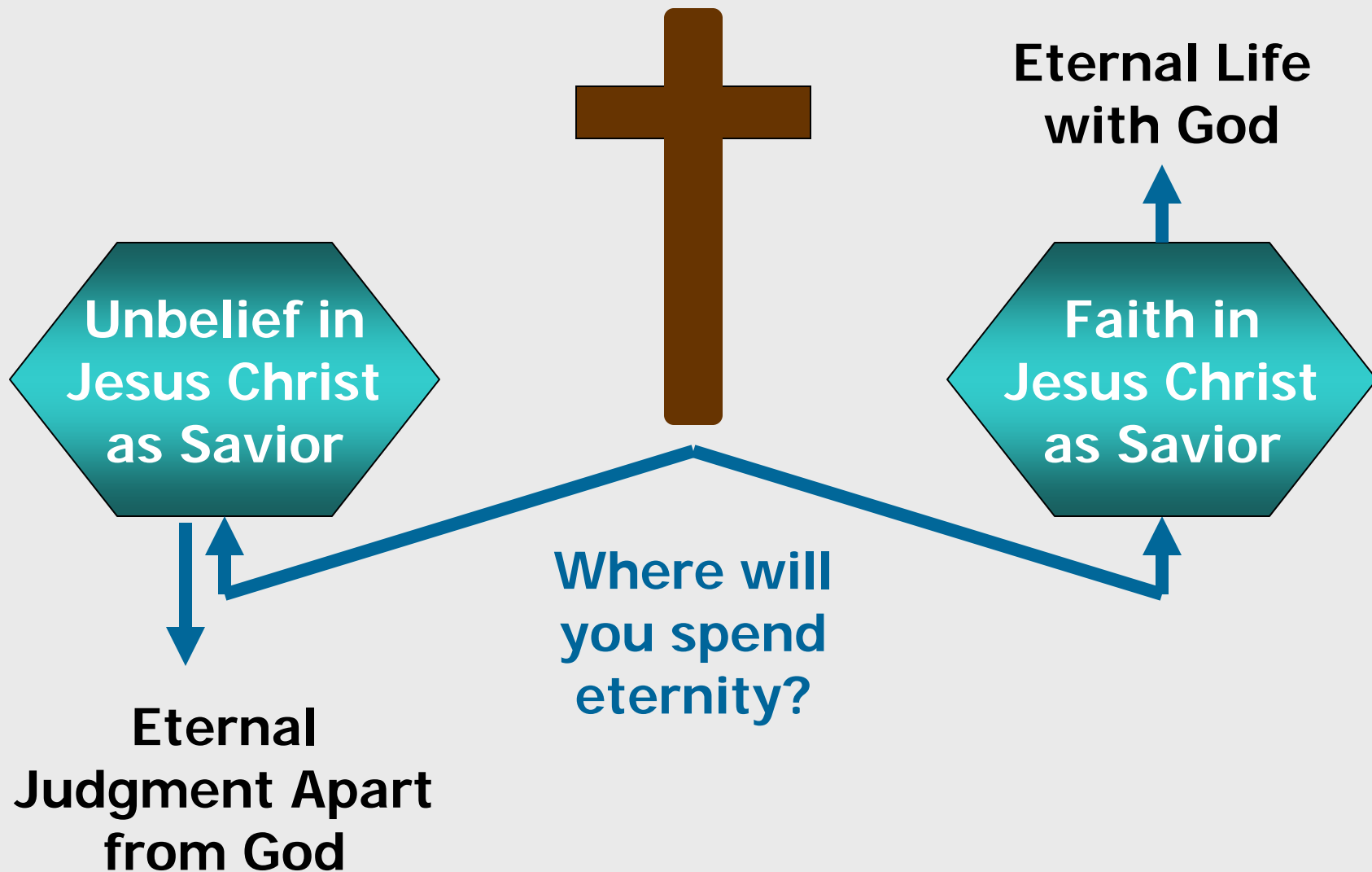

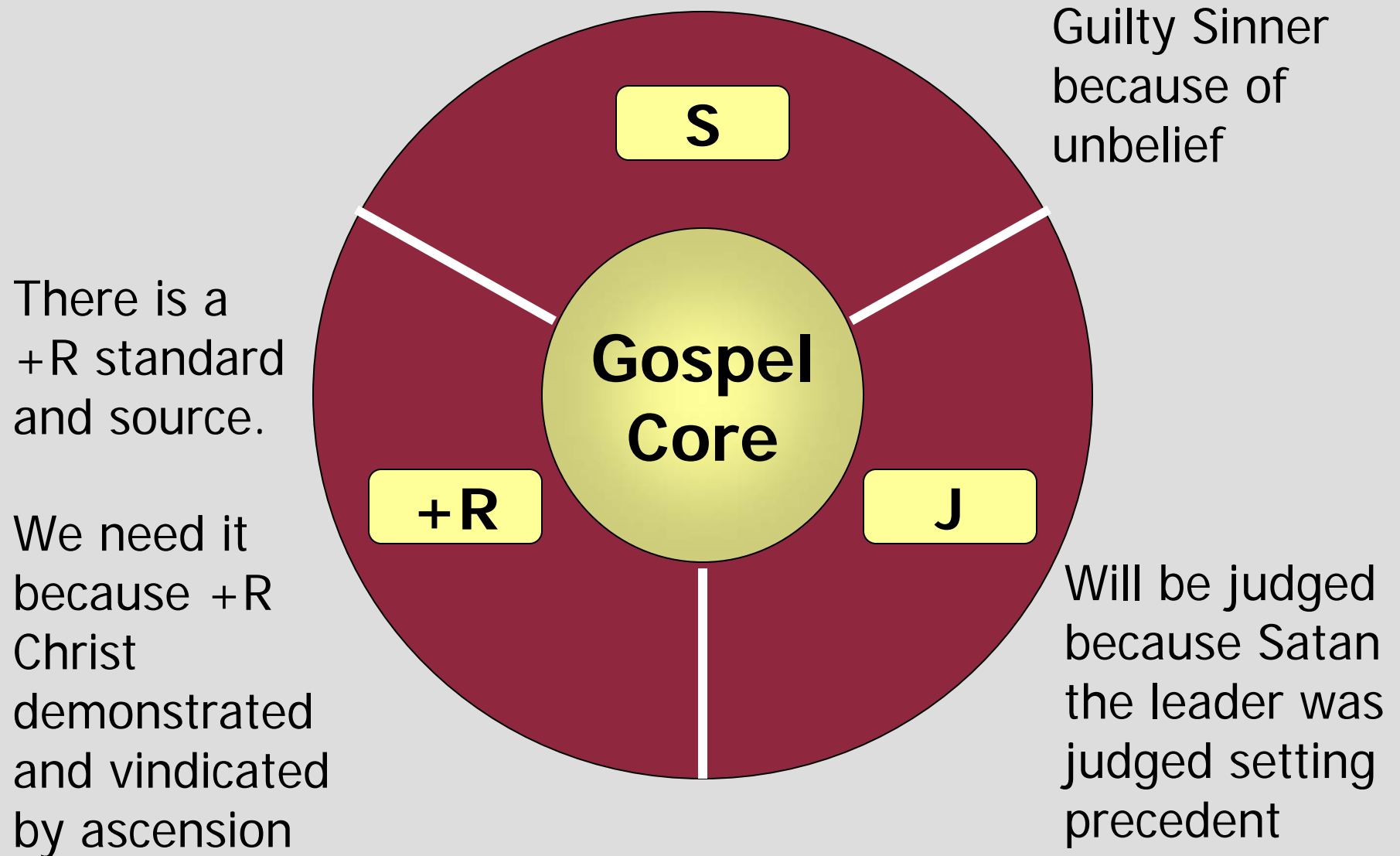

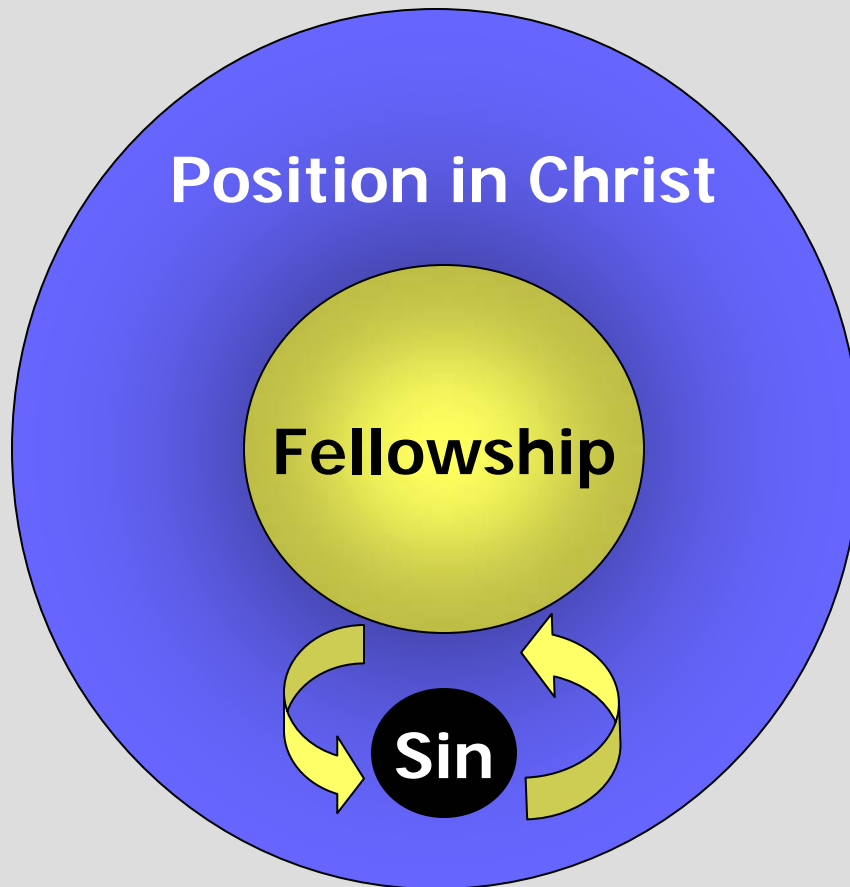
# Your Eternal Destiny: A Faith Decision
